



Project Name: John James Audubon (St. Francisville) Bridge over the Mississippi River

Location: New Roads and St Francisville, LA

Project Facts: The \$348 Million John James Audubon Bridge project is a new Mississippi River crossing between Pointe Coupee and West Feliciana parishes in south central Louisiana. The bridge is proposed to be the longest cable-stayed bridge in North America with a 1,583 lf main span and will replace an existing ferry between the communities of New Roads and St. Francisville.

Services Provided: Spent approx 4 months at the project site assisting the contractor's staff with the development of the detailed procedures to fabricate, install and lower the precast cofferdams into the Mississippi River for the placement of the foundations for the two main span piers.
